

- If you post on social media, remember to use the hashtags: #DoSomeGood #SnapSomeGood and #randomactsofkindness






Recruit volunteers - Post a Virtual Position

With the move to social distancing, there are now numerous skilled workers with time on their hands and a desire to give back. Learn more about <u>posting virtual</u>

volunteer positions.

- · Go to your Management area.
- Choose 'Positions & Events' from your navigation on the left
- Choose " + New Position"
- Fill out the fields
- Be sure to select "This position can be performed remotely, online or via telephone" to create a virtual position that can be accessed from anywhere in Canada
- Then "Publish" and share your position as a story



Our Do Some Good team will be doing everything they can to share these virtual opportunities via our social networks and through our partnerships with local media companies to ensure your organization gets the support it needs.

Examples of Virtual Volunteer Positions

- Grant Writing get someone to help write proposals to secure emergency support and funds for your organization
- Social Media enlist someone to help share positive stories (that are needed right now) and about how your organization has and continues to make an impact in the community
- Accounting have someone help with budgeting, forecasting or overall financial guidance and strategy
- **Letter writing** get people to write emails or letters to the people your organization supports that may not be able to access in-person services right now a great way to brighten someone's day
- Mentorship / Coaching enlist business professionals to offer guidance with business strategy or elevator pitch coaching via a 1-hour phone call
- Virtual Events & Fundraisers have someone run or train your team on how to use online tools to host virtual events
- Graphic Design have someone help with creating graphics for your website or for a social campaign
- Communications have someone help do an audit of your communications or help set up email marketing
- Website Design have someone help update your website and improve your SEO to help with both short-term and long-term success
- **Video/Photo Editing** have someone help take photos or videos that you have, edit them and create resources that you can use to help within your communications





Conduct Outreach and Find Skilled Volunteers

You can access a list of skilled individuals who are willing to help, to make it easy to conduct outreach. Filter the list by the skills that you're in need of and find the perfect person to help during this time!

- Go to your Management area.
- Choose 'Volunteers' from your navigation on the left
- Choose the 'Recruit Interested Volunteers' tab
- · Show people in your area or from anywhere in Canada
- Filter the list by skills you need
- Visit their profile to learn more or message them to ask for their support

Fun Fact: There are already 300+ skilled volunteers near Kelowna willing to be contacted and over 800 across Canada!







Post other Needs on our #CommunityNeeds Marketplace

Do Some Good is getting a number of requests from the community about what they can do to support local nonprofits. As a result, we've created a Community Needs Page where posts with any support you need will be centralized and promoted for the community to see.

- Post a story on our platform about your needs and hashtag #CommunityNeeds.
- Ensure there are clear instructions (e.g. where to drop off a donation item) or contact information so the public can get in touch.
- Share your post to social media.
- That's it! We'll do the rest of the work to make sure the community can see and support your needs.


